PURPOSE

The purpose of this section is to establish and describe the functions of the College of Forestry Safety Committee.

POLICY

The College of Forestry hereby establishes the College of Forestry Safety Committee. The Committee will be composed of at least one representative from each Academic Department, at least one representative from the service groups, and one representative from the College Forests staff. The committee members will be appointed by the respective department or group leaders (ie., Department Heads, College Director of Operations (for service groups), College Forests Director). The Dean will designate the Chair for this Committee. Terms of service will be two years with options for renewal and a rotation schedule to ensure continuity.

Procedure

The College Safety Committee shall work closely with the Environmental Health and Safety Unit of University Facilities Services and the University Safety Committee.
