October 1952 – September 2003

Jerry Sedlak was a 1978 OSU Forest Engineering Masters Alum; served on the Forest Engineering Advisory Board; and assisted regularly with guest lectures, field trips, research efforts, and job opportunities for FE students. He was President of Emerald Valley Thinning; a member of the Associated Oregon Loggers, the Society of American Foresters, and actively involved in the Springfield, Oregon community. Jerry is remembered as an innovative and tenacious logger and forest engineer who coupled his professional engineering background with a deep respect for forestry.

Eligibility Criteria

The Western Region of the Council on Forest Engineering (WR COFE) sponsors **three** \$1,500 scholarships for OSU College of Forestry undergraduate students currently enrolled in either FE, FOM or FE/CE. Scholarships will be awarded at the January WR COFE annual meeting (Winter Term) for the student's educational costs including tuition, fees and books. Additional eligibility criteria are:

- Sophomore, Junior or Senior class standing
- Full Time enrollment
- Minimum accumulated GPA: 2.75

Requirements

- The WR COFE scholarship application
- Unofficial college transcripts
- One letter of recommendation
- Resume
- An original brief essay (see below for details)

Written materials will be reviewed by members of the WR COFE Advisory Board (private forest industry, logging, and OSU Forest Engineering). Candidates will be selected on the basis of the material provided. All applications are confidential. The decision of the WR COFE Advisory Board is final.
