CALL FOR NOMINATIONS: 2017 DEAN'S AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT Deadline: Monday, January 22, 2018 (5pm)

Award Ceremony held March 2018

In 1990, the College of Forestry inaugurated the Dean's Award for Outstanding Achievement to recognize outstanding contributions by faculty and staff that significantly advance the mission of the College. These awards recognize service or performance that is truly exceptional, and "above and beyond" what is expected in a candidate's position description.

The Dean's Award includes a \$1,500 (pre-tax) monetary award and a commemorative plaque. One or more awards will be made to individuals or groups, not necessarily in every category every year. ALL College employees are eligible, and ALL College employees and students may submit nominations.

Nominations should include nomination statement demonstrating how the individual has met the criteria for the award and providing examples of exemplary work conducted in 2017. **Nominations need not be more than a page, an email is sufficient, and signatures are not required.**
