

Your Bachelor's Degree (BS) in TRAL



- A minimum of 180 credits are required for graduation;
 60 must be upper division (300 and 400-level courses).
- A maximum of 124 credits earned at a community college may be applied toward a bachelor's degree at OSU.
- Only courses with letter prefixes and numbers above 100 are accepted.
- TRAL students must complete 6 months of work experience related to their degree.
