The association was founded in 1955 to assist western US hardwoods to a position of prominence in the manufacturing of fine furniture, cabinets, doors, and pallets. THE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The WHA Scholarship award reflects the association's commitment to provide financial assistance to students pursuing a career in the western hardwood and affiliated industries. The 2024 awards will consist of at least 2 scholarships for up to \$2,500 each. Additional scholarships could be awarded depending on the quality of the submissions. Scholarship awards are in the form of checks made payable to the student.

In addition to the scholarship awards, a list of the scholarship nominees will be distributed to all members of the WHA. These companies will be encouraged to consider these nominees when making their summer and full-time hiring decisions. Applicants are encouraged to familiarize themselves with the WHA and learn of the many diverse career opportunities the industry has to offer.

Student must be:

- a citizen or permanent legal resident of the US, Canada or Mexico.
- enrolled full-time in undergraduate or graduate study for the spring of 2025.
- enrolled in one of the following academic majors:

- April 2024: The WHA Board of Directors selects scholarship recipients and award amounts.

- Summer 2024: Scholarship checks will be presented at WHA Annual Convention.


